TIME	ACTIVITY
10.30am	The adventure begins Arrive promptly at the visitor centre to begin your adventure. Your parent will be asked to sign some paperwork and you will receive your 'keeper kit' for the day.
10.40am	Down on the farm Help the keepers carry out routine health checks and 'muck out' the rabbits. Meet our barn owls, a native species to Ireland.
11.20am	Take on a jumbo job! Work with some of Belfast Zoo's largest animals by helping to wash or feed the elephants OR giraffe (species subject to operational requirements).
12pm	Monkey around with animal diets Learn about animals' diets while preparing food for some of the zoo's smallest primates and help to feed these little monkeys.
12.45pm	Your feeding time Time for a much-needed break as you stop for lunch. Head to the Lion's Den Restaurant for a tasty treat (voucher provided).
1.40pm	Slither over to the reptile house Learn about reptiles and amphibians while assisting with the zoo's daily 'keeper talk'. Feed some of the zoo's smallest creatures.
2.10pm	Otterly delicious antics! Learn how animals are differentiated as you feed the spot-necked otter and the giant anteater.
2.35pm	All good things come to an end This is the end of your junior keeper for a day experience.
2.45pm	Have a zooper time in the zoo Spend the rest of the afternoon in the zoo at your leisure, exploring those species you met and new ones.
